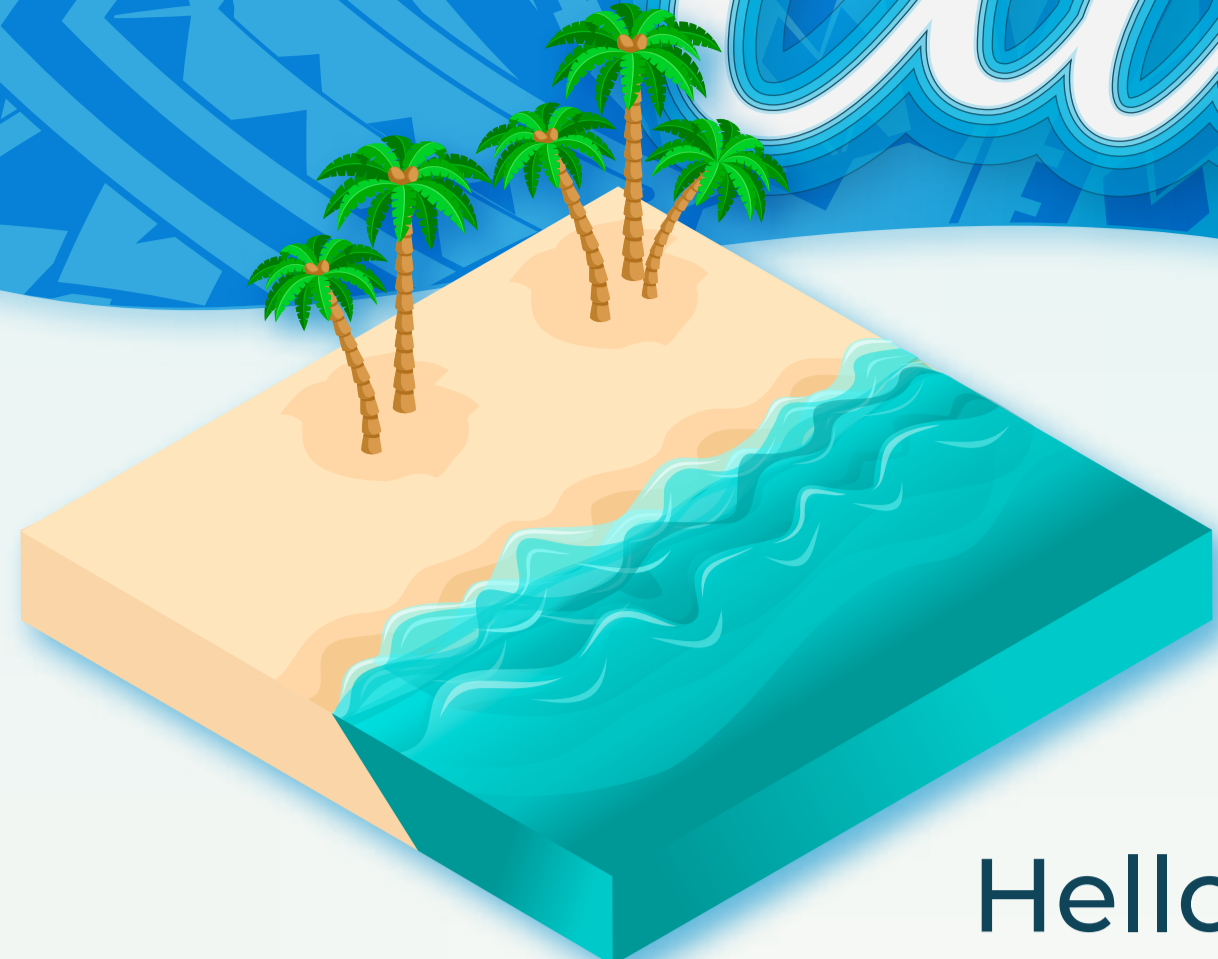

Secluded Beaches & Pools

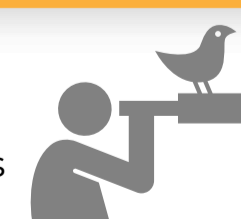
A spectacular scenery of tranquil white sandy beaches and blue lagoon pools situated amongst the rough volcanic landscape.
