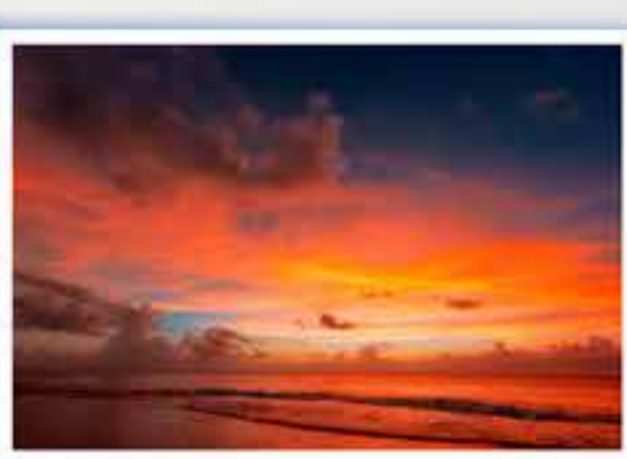

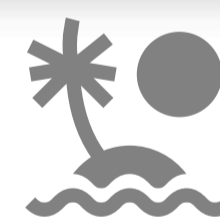


4 Blow-Your-Mind Things To Do When In Atiu, Cook Islands
